### **1. PRE-ENROLMENT application for students who require an entry visa**

**If you are an International student that need an entry visa for Italy for long-term stay,** you must submit the pre-enrolment application on-line through the [UNIVERSITY](#) portal within **July 30<sup>th</sup> 2021**.

### **STUDY VISA TYPE D APPLICATION**

Once the pre-enrolment application is validated by PoliTO you should promptly arrange for a visa application for study purposes at the the Italian Embassy/Consulate of reference in your country of residence. We encourage you in any case to contact the Italian Embassy/Consulate directly to verify that information. Please note that Uni-Italia Association can assist you in the pre-enrolment and visa application process as well. You may refer to Uni-Italia [Center](#) in your country if available.

In case your study visa type D is denied, you cannot complete the enrolment procedure at Politecnico di Torino. We recommend you to contact the Italian Embassy/Consulate directly to get further information on the reasons of denial. In case

you consider applying for the visa again as worthwhile, keep in mind the [enrolment deadlines](#).

Please consider that visa release depends ONLY on the decision of the Italian Embassy/Consulate in your country; universities does not have any possibility to step in in case of visa denial.

## 2. ENROLMENT

Enrolment regulations and procedures are described the specific [Call for admission and Enrolment Regulations for Bachelor's degree programmes a.y. 2021/22](#). Applicants are required to pay the first instalment of their tuition fees in order to complete the first phase of the online enrolment process. The standard amount of the first instalment is 161 euros.

Enrolling students must complete the following steps by **16/11/2021**:

- log in to their Apply@polito personal page and follow the guided procedure to declare that they meet the admission requirements listed in the Annexes to the Call for applications for admission (Annex B and C, or else, Annex A and B, depending on the Call);
- upload the school documents and language certificate required for admission.

By 3/12/2021 the Incoming Mobility Office will verify the documents uploaded by students.

Please be reminded to bring with you all the original enrolment documents while traveling to Torino as long as Politecnico di Torino is entitled to request you to show those originals at any time.

### ➤ **Is it possible to postpone my admission for 2022/23 A.Y?**

No, it's not. The Academic offer is valid only for 2021/22 A.Y. If you want to enroll in the A.Y. 2022/23 you should apply again and repeat the whole procedure within the new deadlines established in winter 2022.

## 3. LANGUAGE KNOWLEDGE

In order to enroll at Politecnico di Torino you have to submit the required [language certificates](#).

Moreover,

- for **bachelor's degree programmes taught in English**, knowledge of the Italian language is a graduation requirement (it is necessary to pass an Italian language exam at a minimum level of A2 to graduate). Students can submit a PLIDA A2 certification or replacement certification or take the internal exam at the Politecnico. Please check the [Student Guide 2020/21](#) (Foreign Language Learning – Italian Language) for further details.  
The [Language Center \(CLA\)](#) offers free Italian language courses, level A2 and B1 to all international students.

**International students are advised to learn Italian in any case as**, not only the success of your studies, but also the enjoyment of your time in Turin will depend upon your ability to speak Italian.

- For **bachelor's degree programmes taught in Italian**, it is required to pass the English language exam at level B2 or higher as a graduation requirement. Please check the [Student Guide 2020/21](#) (Foreign Language Learning – English Language) for further details.

#### 4. CREDIT RECOGNITION

Students enrolling in a Bachelor degree program can apply for recognition of credits earned in a Bachelor degree program in a foreign university.

It is possible to apply for credit recognition through APPLY@polito and according to the rules published [here](#) within **31/8/2021**.

#### 5. WHEN YOU SHOULD ARRIVE IN TORINO and COVID-19 DISPOSITIONS

We recommend arriving in Torino slightly before the beginning of classes starting from **27/9/2021**. Moreover, to plan your arrival please consider as well the deadlines to submit your EDISU application – see paragraph 8 below.

The arrival date will depend on the prevention and protection measures which will be adopted to control the Covid-19 pandemic. Moreover, for candidates who need a

visa to enter Italy, it will depend also on the actual issuing of the study visa. In any case, these candidates should arrange for a visa application for study purposes at the Italian Embassy/Consulate, in order to use this visa as soon as conditions allow them to travel to Italy.

### ➤ **Academic activities A.Y. 2021/22**

During next academic year, Politecnico is going to deliver **in-person classes**. However, in order to guarantee the sustainability of a safe teaching reorganization, a limited amount of activities may be held remotely.

Students are expected to take **exams and final examinations in person**.

Given that international students must have a valid visa to enrol at Italian universities, in the event of travel limitations imposed by the government, you will have the opportunity to attend online classes and possibly take exams remotely, if necessary: this does not mean that it is your free choice to attend classes in presence or online, but that only in the case of travel limitations for study reasons imposed by the Italian Government, the University will allow you to attend online classes until the expiry of those limitations.

### ➤ **Study plan**

We advise you to verify the study plan of the first year of the Bachelor program you are admitted to in order to prepare in advance the classes of the 1<sup>st</sup> year and to get further studying material in your own country.

## 7. TUITION FEES

The amount of tuition fees varies according to the citizenship/residence of the student ([click to acknowledge your own situation](#)) and it must be paid in two instalments:

- the first one upon enrolment
- the second one in March

The deadlines to apply for fee reduction are mentioned in the Fee Guide. In order to apply for the ISEE Parificato (compulsory document for students with a foreign income) in a CAF office, you are required to submit the following documents:

- the family composition

These documents must be translated into Italian and certified by the Italian Embassy or Consulate.

## 8. GRANTS and SCHOLARSHIPS

### TOPoliTO Scholarships

The "TOPoliTO: attracting international Top students at the Politecnico di Torino" project offers scholarships to the best international students who will enroll for the first time in a.y. 2021/22 in a Bachelor of Science program of Politecnico di Torino. The gross amount of the scholarship is 8.000 € per year for the 3 years of the program.

You can participate if you score of at least 60/100 at the admission test.

### Competition for EDISU benefits

EDISU Piemonte, the Regional Agency for the Right to University Education of Piemonte, aims at promoting the admission and the attendance of academic studies to deserving students who find themselves in financial need, in the framework of the competences relating to the right to academic studies attributed by the Italian law to State, Regions and Universities.

EDISU provides support to the study attendance and life of students through the following benefits, granted by public competition:

- **accommodation service:** it offers an accommodation, assigned by competition, in one of EDISU halls of residences located in Turin and in other towns of Piemonte where there are university branches. The offered accommodation is not chosen by the student enrolled in any University of Piemonte, but assigned on the basis of a ranking list resulting from the public competition;

- **scholarship:** it is an amount of money, paid out in two installments, and awarded on competition to students enrolled in any University of Piemonte.

The application should be submitted according to the procedures and deadlines set in the specific public competition published each year.
