1. PRE-ENROLMENT application for students who require an entry visa

If you are an International student that need an entry visa for Italy for long-term stay, you must submit the pre-enrolment application on-line through the [UNIVERSITALY](#) portal within July 30th 2021.

STUDY VISA TYPE D APPLICATION

Once the pre-enrolment application is validated by PoliTO you should promptly arrange for a visa application for study purposes at the the Italian Embassy/Consulate of reference in your country of residence. The required documents for visa application are detailed here (starting form p. 12):

We encourage you in any case to contact the Italian Embassy/Consulate directly to verify that information. Please note that Uni-Italia Association can assist you in the pre-enrolment and visa application process as well. You may refer to Uni-Italia [Center](#) in your country if available.



In case your study visa type D is denied, you cannot complete the enrolment procedure at Politecnico di Torino. We recommend you to contact the Italian Embassy/Consulate directly to get further information on the reasons of denial. In case you consider applying for the visa again as worthwhile, keep in mind the [enrolment deadlines](#).

Please consider that visa release depends ONLY on the decision of the Italian Embassy/Consulate in your country; universities does not have any possibility to step in in case of visa denial.

2. ENROLMENT

Enrolment regulations and procedures are described in the guidelines for enrollment published at: https://international.polito.it/admission/prospective_students/master_of_science/2022_23/enrolment/enrolment_in_the_1st_term

In order to enroll students must pay the first instalment tuition fees amounting to **161 euro** through the online procedure within the following deadlines:

- Master of Science programs in Architecture Construction City - Architecture for Sustainability - Architecture for Heritage: **4th October 2022**
- Master of Science programs in Engineering - Digital Skills for Sustainable Societal Transitions - Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning - Systemic Design: **13th October 2022**

After the payment you will get a new STUDENT ID NUMBER and password to log in to the Teaching Portal where you will have to attach all the [enrolment documents including the language certification](#) no later than 13th October 2022 (section *Teaching Portal/Online Services/Attachments*).

The Incoming Mobility Office will verify the enrolment documents within November 10, 2022.

Please be reminded to bring with you all the original enrolment documents while traveling to Torino as long as Politecnico di Torino is entitled to request you to show those originals at any time.

➤ **What can I do in case I wish to change the Master of Science program? Can I do it upon arrival?**

If the Academic Commission evaluated you eligible for both MSc programs you applied for, during the virtual appointment you will be able to choose which one of the 2 programs you want to enroll in.



➤ **Is it possible to postpone my admission for 2023/24 A.Y.?**

No, it's not. The Academic offer is valid only for 2022/23 A.Y. If you want to enroll in the A.Y. 2023/24 you should apply again and repeat the whole procedure within the new deadlines established in autumn 2022.

3. LANGUAGE KNOWLEDGE

In order to enroll at Politecnico di Torino it is necessary to submit the required [language certificates](#).

For more information about **graduation requirements** please refer to the Student Guide of your Bsc program - Foreign Language Learning.

The [University Language Centre \(CLA\)](#) offers free Italian language course at different level.

We recommend learning Italian in any case: this will enhance your whole life experience in Italy.

4. CREDIT TRANSFER

Students enrolling in a Master degree program can apply for recognition of credits earned in a Master degree program in a foreign university.

It is possible to apply for credit transfer through APPLY@polito and according to the rules published [here](#) within August 31st, 2022.

5. WHEN YOU SHOULD ARRIVE IN TORINO

We recommend arriving in Torino slightly before the beginning of classes, **September 26th, 2022**.

Moreover, to plan your arrival please consider as well the deadlines to submit your EDISU application – see paragraph 8 below.

The arrival date may depend on the prevention and protection measures which will be adopted by your country and by [Italy](#) to control the Covid-19 pandemic. For international students who need a visa to enter Italy, it will depend also on the actual issuing of the study visa. In any case, these candidates should arrange for a visa application for study purposes at the Italian Embassy/Consulate, in order to use this visa as soon as conditions allow them to travel to Italy.



➤ **Academic activities A.Y. 2022/23**

Classes and exam sessions will be held in-person.

Remote classes are not guaranteed as well as remote exam sessions.

➤ **Study plan**

We advise you to verify the study plan of the first year of the Master program you are admitted to in order to prepare in advance the classes of the 1st year and to get further studying material in your own country.

Read carefully the [Student guide](#) for your Master degree program for all info related to your academic career as: study plan, classes timetable, tuition fees, etc.

Fill in your study plan according to the deadlines set in the Student Guide - Creating your PSP (Personal Study Plan).

6. ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The academic year is divided into two semesters, the first one starting on September 27th, 2021 and the second one on February 28th, 2022.

7. TUITION FEES

The amount of tuition fees varies according to the citizenship/residence of the student ([click to acknowledge your own situation](#)) and it must be paid in two instalments:

- the first one upon enrolment
- the second one in March

The deadlines to apply for fee reduction are mentioned in the Fee Guide. In order to apply for the ISEE Parificato (compulsory document for students with a foreign income) in a CAF office, you are required to submit the following documents:

- the family composition
- the family income (economic condition) of the whole family unit
- the family properties

These documents must be translated into Italian and certified by the Italian Embassy or Consulate.

Competition for EDISU benefits



EDISU Piemonte, the Regional Agency for the Right to University Education of Piemonte, aims at promoting the admission and the attendance of academic studies to deserving students who find themselves in financial need, in the framework of the competences relating to the right to academic studies attributed by the Italian law to State, Regions and Universities.

EDISU provides support to the study attendance and life of students through the following benefits, granted by public competition:

- **accommodation service:** it offers an accommodation, assigned by competition, in one of EDISU halls of residences located in Turin and in other towns of Piemonte where there are university branches. The offered accommodation is not chosen by the student enrolled in any University of Piemonte, but assigned on the basis of a ranking list resulting from the public competition;
- **scholarship:** it is an amount of money, paid out in two installments, and awarded on competition to students enrolled in any University of Piemonte.

The application should be submitted according to the procedures and deadlines set in the specific public competition published each year.
